The model is designed to generate high quality images that are diverse, which can enhance creativity and internalized learning in the classroom.

Additionally, we keep administrators in the driver's seat, with the ability to toggle on and off our generative AI features. Lastly, with the Content Authenticity Initiative (CAI), Adobe is setting the industry standard for responsible generative AI. The CAI offers free, publicly available open-source tools and is working on a widely adopted technical standard in collaboration with leading technology organizations through the nonprofit Coalition for Content Provenance and Authenticity (C2PA). When users export content that includes Firefly-generated output, Adobe will automatically apply a Content Credential to disclose the use of generative AI, which can help distinguish the content from work created without generative AI.
